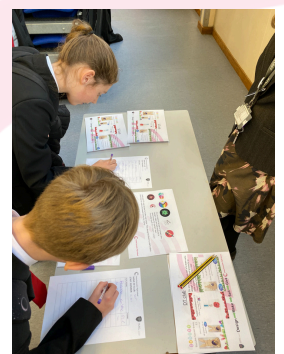
Extra-Curricular Fair
