## UCAS - The main event – our live exhibition with employers!

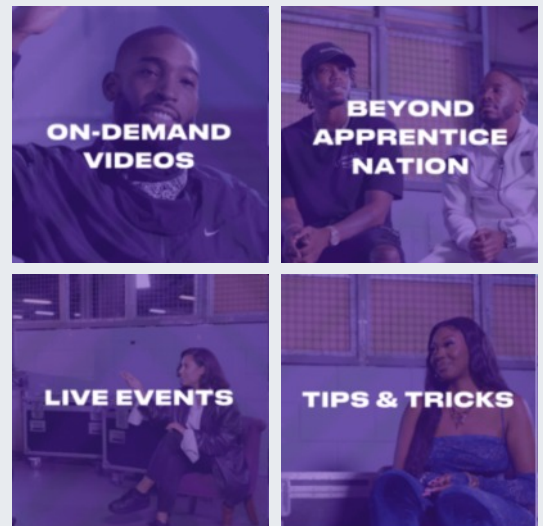
