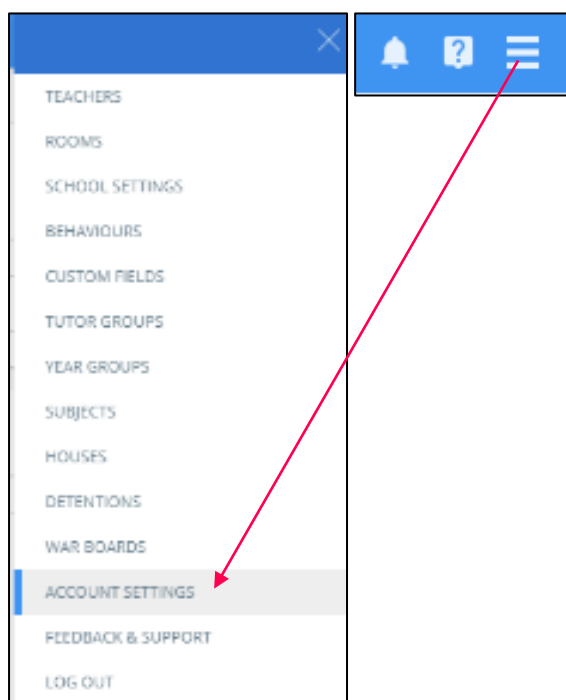



Classcharts Email notification - Updates

Classcharts have introduced some new features that I think will be beneficial to share with you. The first new feature is that you can now set it to receive a daily email to tell you about your homework submissions for the day. This will show you who has submitted work and save you time from having to dig through each group to find new submissions.

To enable this feature, you will first need to access your Classcharts **ACCOUNT SETTINGS**

In the **SETTINGS** page, find the option named

“Email homework submission summary for classes I teach”
and set this to **Enabled**.

You can then choose a time of day that the email will be sent – set this to a time that suits you – you will get one email per day at roughly that time.

You will then receive an email similar to this (Thanks to Michelle for testing this for me!):



Once you have enabled this option it may take a day for it to become active, so please be patient, and let me know if you don't get any emails (also check the junk folder!).


Another option they have added is the LIST feature on the homework calendar. By clicking on the **HOMEWORK CALENDAR** link on the blue bar, you can switch to **LIST** view.

From there you can filter Lesson, Year, Teacher etc. and it will display those homework tasks. This will allow you to quickly look at tasks and check submissions without having to manually go through each class as previous.
