Dear Parent or Carer

Re: Collection of results – Thursday 12th August, 9.30am – midday.

I hope you are all well. I am writing to give you details of the collection procedures for the year 11 results in August.

Your child's Key Stage 4 results will be available to collect from school on Thursday 12th August. Each house group will be allocated a different collection time to help ease pupils' arrivals and exits. Below are the arrival times for each house group:

Clougha: 9.30 Lune: 9.50 Halton: 10.10 Storey 1: 10.30 Storey 2: 10.50

Your child's results will be available to collect from the quad area near the hall. Please ask your child to make their way to the Y9 entrance/ C floor entrance where they will be guided by members of staff to receive their results. There will be staff on hand to advise on next steps such as advice on college and sixth-form applications.

If results have not been collected on the day, they will be available for collection on 1st September when the school reopens. The results **must be collected by the pupil**, we are not allowed to hand results to parents/carers. If you are not able to collect the results in person, please either hand in a stamped, addressed envelope with your home address by 16th July or send us an envelope in the post.

If your child has a computer loaned by the school for use during lockdown then it is very important that it is returned to the school by the end of term (16th July) or brought on results day.

Grades this summer were based on Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs). TAGs were submitted to the exam boards by the school as a holistic assessment of pupils' performance in a subject. This followed a rigorous process of assessment, moderation and quality assurance. These grades will then be approved by the relevant exam board, following external quality assurance checks. Vocational qualifications followed the exam board guidance on the submission of a portfolio of course work evidence which has been moderated by the exam board.

If you or your child are unhappy with the results that they receive in the summer, there is the option to



request a centre review to be carried out. For full details about the TAGs procedure, including details of submitting a request for a centre review please visit our website at:

They are a credit to all parents and carers, and we are immensely proud of them all.
