## RE Notification of changes to fares on Stagecoach buses in North Lancashire from $\rm 16^{th}$ July 2025

I write as a courtesy to inform you that fares are changing on bus services provided by us with effect from 16<sup>th</sup> July. These changes affect local service buses and not dedicated school buses.

I am aware that some students rely on our buses to travel to and from school, and in some cases are given specific change by parents or guardians to pay for bus travel.

In order to avoid situations where children may not have the correct fare to pay for their journey to school, I would be grateful if you could distribute information about this change to fares as you deem appropriate.

Details of the changes are provided below and more information can be viewed on our website or via our journey planner.

#### Single tickets:

Most single tickets will see no change in price. Those single tickets priced at £2 (£1.30 child) & £2.30 (£1.50 child) will increase by 10p. All other single tickets will remain frozen in price. The maximum price of a single journey will remain capped at £3.
