

Geography is a facilitating subject along with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Maths and Further Maths, English, History and Classical and Modern Languages.






Three examinations at the end of Year 11:

- Unit 3 (1hr 15mins) tests Fieldwork and contains a Decision Making Exercise. 30% of final grade





