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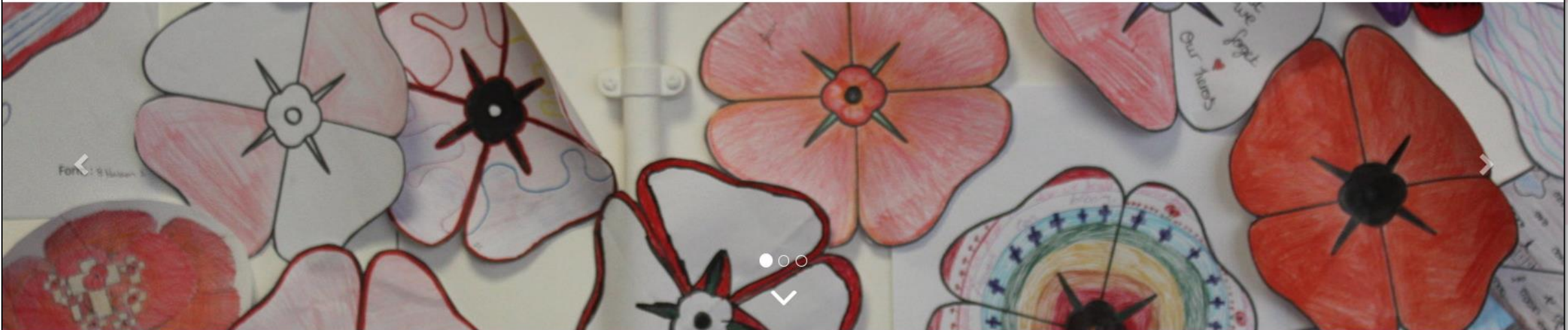

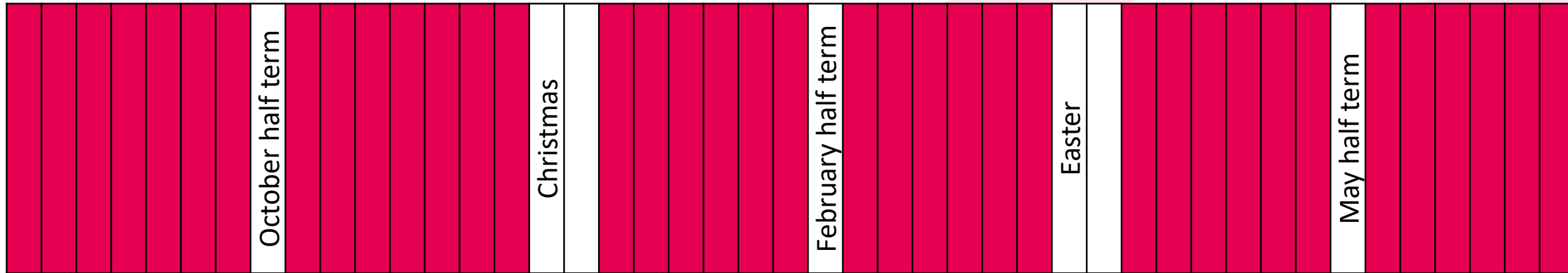
### Year 11 Mock Examinations

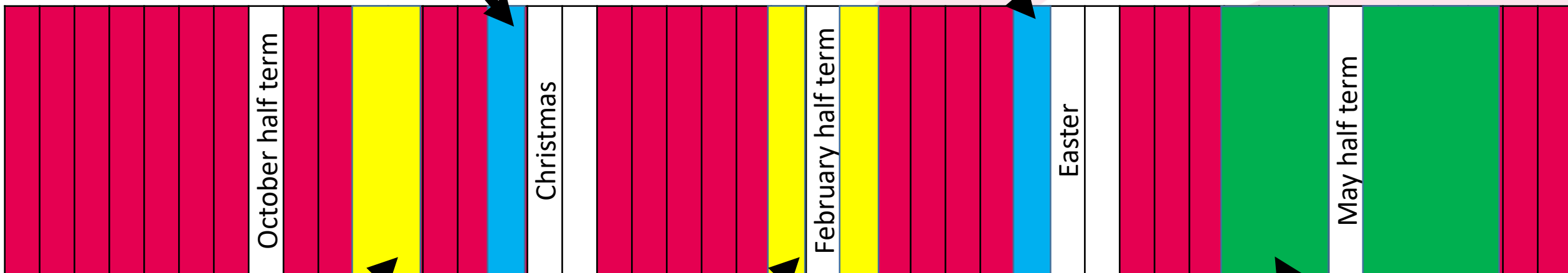

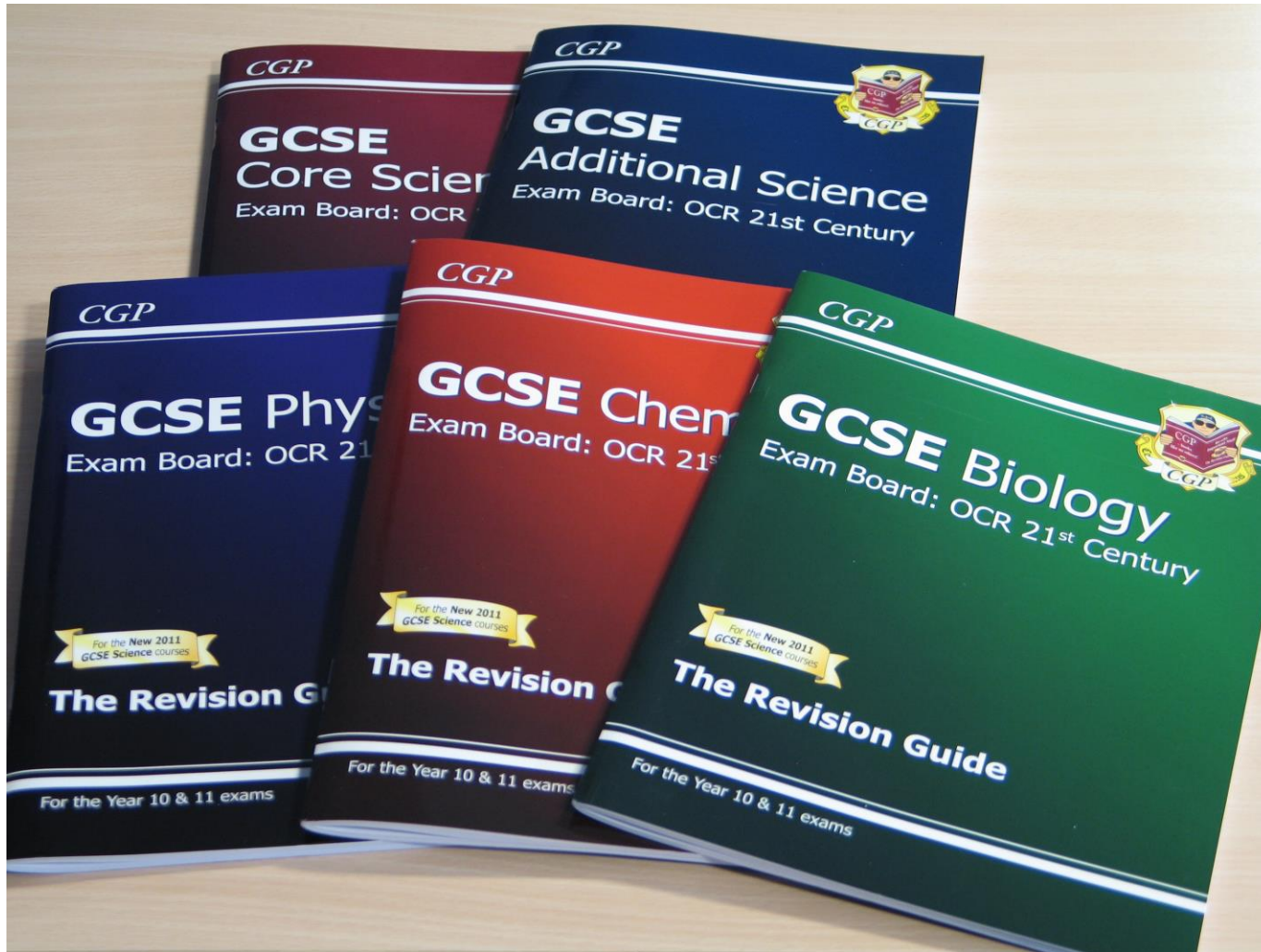


# What we're doing in tutor time
