Dear Parent/Carer,

We are excited to announce that our Year 11 Prom celebration will take place at The Globe Arena Morecambe on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June.

In today's assembly, all Year 11 pupils have been given a 'Save the Date' invitation. We very much look forward to this event in our school calendar, it is always a wonderful evening and a superb 'send off' for our departing year group.

Our end of Year 11 events include the Prom and the Year 11 Farewell breakfast celebration (shirt signing post exams) is a privilege for pupils to attend, pupils have been given very clear expectations to be able to receive their formal invitation. It is important that all parents understand the expectations and will help and support their child in being successful this term to receive their invitation.

The criteria to enable pupils to secure their formal invitation to Prom requires pupils to have none of the behaviours below from 7<sup>th</sup> January – 21<sup>st</sup> May 2025.

- 0 suspensions
- 0 lesson trancies
- 0 missed after school detentions
- No late marks; to school or lessons
- No child on child abuse behaviours towards other pupils
- No more than 2 exits in a week
- No more than 1 impact in a half term
- 90+% attendance at intervention sessions held during morning form times
- Engagement with optional revision sessions


In addition, pupils must have 97% attendance\* 7<sup>th</sup> January-23<sup>rd</sup> May. The reasons for absence will be considered for each pupil prior to formal invitations being sent home. Formal invitations will be posted to families on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> May.

In the event that pupils miss a GCSE exam under unauthorised circumstances then access to both Prom and the end of Year 11 Farewell will not be granted. Any monies paid for the prom ticket will be reimbursed.

In addition, we will be running our 'Golden Ticket' programme of rewards again this year. In half term 3-5 teachers will nominate a pupil who they feel is deserving of a free ticket to the prom based on their demonstration of the school's 3C values in Year 11. As an addition this year, we will also issue another three free tickets to pupils who made exceptional progress and shown determined commitment to their revision and intervention from January to May.
