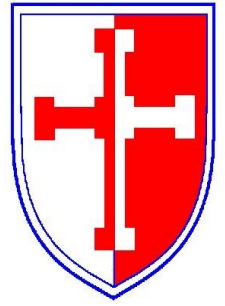




School Uniform Policy



Please make sure all clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name.

Long hair must be tied up (both male and female). Only watches and stud earrings are allowed in school. Children will be asked to remove any other jewellery. For PE/Games all watches and earrings **MUST** be removed by the child.

The school will take no responsibility for any item of value brought into the school.

If you are considering having your child's ears pierced can we suggest that this is done at the beginning of the summer holidays at the end of July as this will give plenty of time for ears to heal and children to learn to take their earrings out themselves before the start of the Autumn Term.

Why do we need a school uniform policy?

Wearing a school uniforms allows children to feel valued as a member of our caring Christian community. Ensuring that children wear a uniform allows them to increase their self-esteem, self-worth and sense of belonging in our Federation. Additionally, a uniform helps prepare children for later life by enabling them to develop a sense of responsibility and pride in their appearance which can directly influence their attitude towards their learning.

Parental Support

Whilst as a Federation we acknowledge the importance of correct school uniform, we also recognise that this can cause additional stress for families who are going through difficult times. In order to support members of our school community, we hold uniform donations at both schools. The pastoral team are then able to contact families who require help with the purchase of uniforms. Additionally on class dojo, posts are published to encourage parents to seek help from school with concerns regarding uniform.
