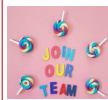
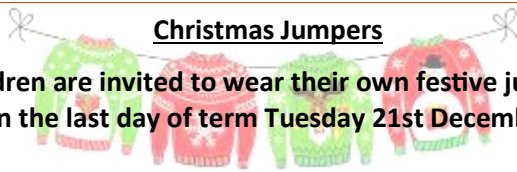
**Please note that classroom doors will be opened at 8:40am and close promptly at 8.50am after which time your child will need to be signed in at the school office.**

Children are invited to wear their own festive jumper on the last day of term Tuesday 21st December



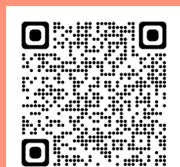

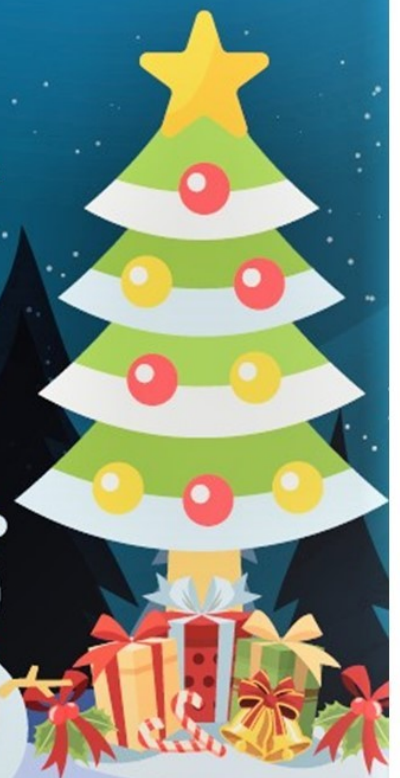
