We want everyone to have the skills to save a life and the best way to build people's confidence is to start young. First aid education increases the number of children and young people able and willing to help in an emergency.

Therefore, we are very thankful to Chapta for funding the first aid training that took place this week for every child in the school.

Our younger children had shorter sessions and learnt how to deal with a cut, a bump on the head and that the best position for someone who is poorly, is on their side. They also learnt to dial 999 in case of an emergency and that they would have to give their address. The children practised making these calls during some role play.

Children in KS2 took part in 1 ½ hour sessions where they learnt to deal with bumps, burns, breaks and bleeding, carried out CPR and dealt with choking. The sessions were practical, lots of fun and involved lots of activities that the children enjoyed.

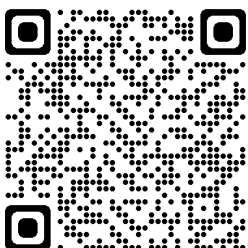
