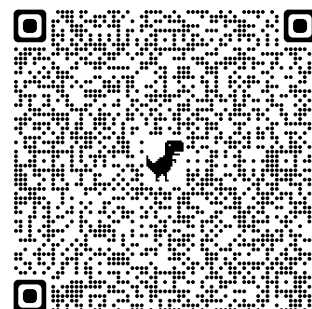
Free School Meals end for pupils at the end of Year 2.
