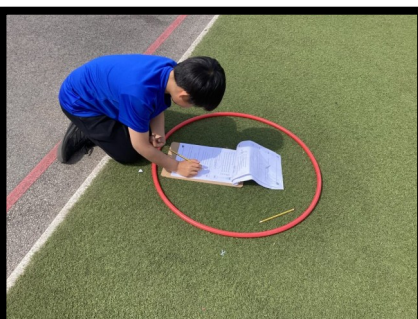
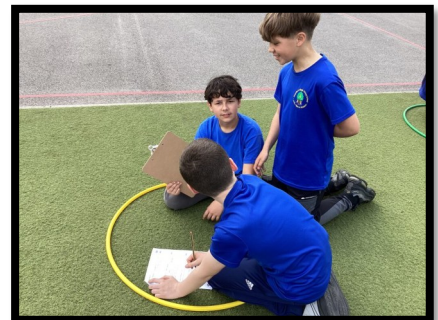
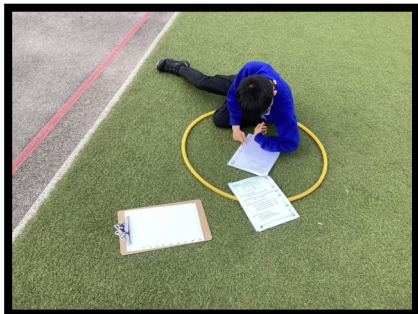
SATs Superstars

We just *can't wait to be king of the stage...* 🤔🤔

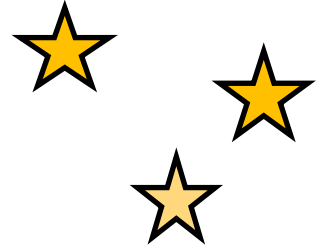


Out of School Achievements
