This week year 6 have been telling me all about their learning. They are absolutely loving their English text, *The Explorer* by Katherine Rundell. The novel begins with a dramatic event: four children are travelling in a light aircraft across the Amazon jungle, which then crashes. The four children, five year-old Max, his older sister Lila and Con and Fred, find themselves alone and have to navigate the jungle. Our year 6 children have produced some fantastic writing based on the text and had the opportunity to practice using semi colons and speech. In maths, they have been focusing on fractions and percentages. They are becoming confident in applying these skills into solving problems.

Year 5 have been learning about the planets in science. They have been thinking about the orbit of the earth and how it tilts on its axis resulting in a shorter or longer day. Linking to their learning, the children have been reading the book, *The Darkest Dark*. The story is based on Astronaut Chris Hadfield and the decisions that led him to want to travel to space. Their end writing outcome will be a biography.

Our EYFS have loved having their visitors in their class but sadly, the baby chicks and ducks are growing rapidly and need to return to the farm. The children will be sad saying goodbye but have thoroughly enjoyed the experience of watching them hatch and start to grow.
