Learning in school is more than academic achievement and so our values here at Chapelford are for every child to learn, achieve and to demonstrate mutual respect. We celebrate children's achievements and promote the values of perseverance, resilience, team working and effective participation. We strongly believe that rewards have a motivational role, helping children to see that good behaviour is valued and so we provide a consistent reward system that supports individual, class and team rewards.

We are sure that your children tell you all about the Dojo rewards which they love to receive in the classroom. Children can choose to spend their dojos weekly on a reward or they can be saved each week to spend on a bigger reward. Additionally, each week, the class can earn a whole class reward if the combined amount of dojos earned by the class exceeds 300. However, to be able to participate in the collective Dojo reward time, a child must have earned at least 5 individual dojos that week.

Our emphasis on rewards to reinforce good behaviour goes beyond the classroom too and so house points are given to reward children spotted showing positive values around the school. All children are already arranged into houses and your child will be in one of the four houses, St George, St Andrew, St David, St Patrick. Children can also earn a house point if they receive one of the weekly certificates in assembly for exceptional behaviour or performance. The lunchtime reward system is also linked to our house points. Our MDAs give out coloured pom poms which are counted weekly. The house with the most amount of pom poms is rewarded with fifty house points.

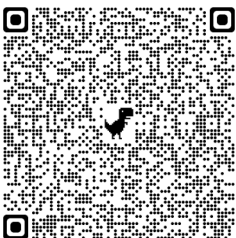

Most exciting of all will be the end of year treat that the overall house winners will be part of in the summer term. A previous treat was a beach party held on the school field.
