SCHOOL UNIFORM

As we approach the end of the school year, we know that many parents and carers will begin to purchase new school uniform, including PE kit, ready for September.

To support you with this, please see the information below outlining the items your child will need. We have also included details of where some of these items can be purchased, including retailers who currently have discounts and offers available.



PE KIT

For PE, all children, including children in Reception, should come into school wearing their PE kit on their designated PE days, which will be shared with families each term. Children should wear a royal blue round-neck T-shirt with plain black or navy-blue shorts (mid-length), leggings or joggers. Footwear should be all black or all white trainers (branded styles are acceptable if the branding is discreet and has minimal colour), or non-branded trainers. Children should also wear their school jumper, cardigan, sports jacket or fleece, ensuring these do not have hoods.

Health & Safety Reminders

- ◆ **Reminder vaping is prohibited on the school grounds. Please do not use your vape until you are on the outside of the school gates. Thank you for your co-operation.**

- ◆ Could we please politely remind parents to take care driving around both front and rear car parks at school drop off and pick up times, paying particular attention to the crossings as there has previously been a few near misses. Chapelford are still working with Roberts Recycling - a specialist clothing bank company to raise funds for school. 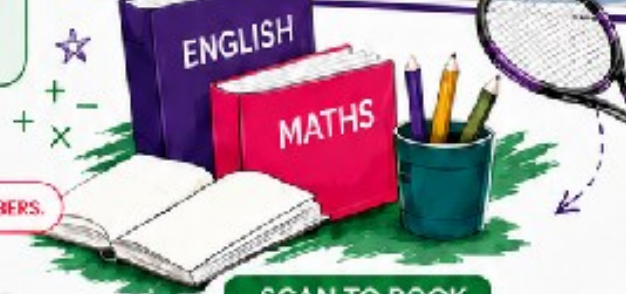
