



## Your Guide to our School Uniform

Learn - Achieve - Respect

#### PRINCIPLES

It is our policy that all children should wear clothing that is in keeping with a purposeful learning ethos. We also believe it is important that certain activities are facilitated by specialised and appropriate clothing when attending school, or when participating in a school–organised event outside normal school hours. We provide a complete list overleaf of the items needed for children's school uniform.

#### Children can wear...

- $\Rightarrow$  School Royal Blue sweatshirt (logo optional)
- $\Rightarrow$  School Royal Blue cardigan (logo optional)
- $\Rightarrow$  School Pale Blue polo shirt (logo optional)
- $\Rightarrow$  Blue Blouse
- $\Rightarrow$  Grey or Black Skirt/Pinafore dress
- $\Rightarrow$  Blue & White gingham summer dress
- $\Rightarrow$  Black shoes with a flat sole
- $\Rightarrow$  School Royal Blue Sweatshirt
- $\Rightarrow$  School blue polo shirt
- $\Rightarrow$  Blue Shirt
- $\Rightarrow$  Grey or Black trousers
- $\Rightarrow$  Grey or Black shorts
- $\Rightarrow$  Black shoes

#### **Optional Items...**

- School Royal Blue fleece and/or reversible fleece jacket (school logo optional)
- School Royal Blue cap with school logo
- School Royal Blue fleece -as above

#### Footwear...

Black shoes with flat heel.

Boots, flip flops, sandals, trainers, jellies or crocs are not appropriate footwear for school.

If it is a wet or cold day an your child needs to wear wellies or warm boots to travel to school, please make sure they have normal school shoes to change into.

#### AIMS

Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform promotes a sense of pride in the school and encourages a feeling of community and belonging. A uniform which is practical and smart and identifies the children with the school which is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be) makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents has been designed with health and safety in mind.

#### For PE all children need:

- A draw string gym bag
- School WHITE t-shirt (logo optional no other logos are permitted)
- ♦ School blue/black PE shorts (No logo)
- Black Pumps

#### <u>Please Note</u>: PE kits should be kept in school all week and be fully named

#### Jewellery...

A single earing in the lobe of each ear i.e a single pair of small studs may be worn. These must be covered with tape during P.E sessions to comply with Health and Safety regulations.

#### Make-Up and Cosmetics...

Make up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform. The school does not permit such products to be worn by any children, unless there is a specific event for which the Head has given permission.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

#### Our School Logo is optional.
