Autumn Term After-School Clubs

Dear parents and carers,

I am writing to you to share information about the after-curricular clubs available for your child to sign up to and attend throughout the autumn term.

At our school, we believe that participating in an after-school club is a fun and valuable opportunity for children to explore their interests, develop new skills, and make new friends. Whether your child is passionate about sports, enjoys creative activities, or is curious to try something new, we have a club that will capture their interest. As part of our commitment to listening to our pupils, our school councillors collected *pupil voice* during the summer term to find out what children would like to see in our club offerings. One clear request was for more creative opportunities and we've taken that on board. Alongside our ever-popular Arts and Crafts, we are excited to introduce Stage Craft and we are pleased to announce that Sign Language, including Sign and Sing, is back by popular demand!

We encourage you to take some time to review the club options with your child and consider enrolling them in an activity that aligns with their interests. Whether they enjoy sports, the arts, or exploring new hobbies, there is something for everyone to enjoy. Clubs will take place on designated days after school, and our dedicated staff will ensure that all sessions are delivered in a safe, supportive, and enjoyable environment. Please find an overview of the clubs attached to this letter, which includes all the information you will need to make an informed choice and complete the sign-up process

If your child would like to join a club, you can sign up easily via our ParentMail shop. Please note that places are allocated on a first come, first served basis and spaces are limited for each club. Sign-ups will open on Wednesday 10th September at 5:00pm, and payment can be made online only. Clubs will run for 11 weeks across the autumn term, except Hula Hula Fun which will run for 10 weeks. All clubs will start on the week commencing Monday 15th September and conclude the week commencing Monday 8th December. Please note that there will be no clubs during the week beginning Monday 20th October due to whole school parents' evening.

We are grateful for your continued support in ensuring children are collected promptly after clubs. <u>All clubs finish in time for children to be collected at 4:15pm, except Gym, which ends at 4:20pm.</u>
Collection points vary depending on the club; please refer to the attached club overview for details. It is important that children are collected by an adult. We ask you to keep in mind that club staff may not recognise all parents and carers and to be patient during collection. Year 5 and 6 children may walk home independently, but only if specific permission has been given for that club (separate from regular end-of-day permissions). Please email or inform the school office if this applies so we can add this to the club register. Children without this specific permission will be unable to walk home.

While we understand that occasional delays can happen due to unforeseen circumstances, late collection can cause children to feel anxious and also impacts the working hours and personal commitments of our staff. If you're running late, please call the school. Children not collected within **5 minutes** will be taken to the front office and supervised by a member of our Senior Leadership Team (SLT) while we contact home. Repeated late collections may lead to a conversation with SLT to explore alternative after-school arrangements. Thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation with this matter.

Sports clubs are usually held outdoors, and as the hall is in use, alternative indoor space is not available during poor weather. Clubs will still run in typical British weather (cold, drizzle, wind) but will be cancelled if the weather conditions pose a risk to the health and safety of the children. We understand that short-notice cancellations can be challenging and aim to avoid them where possible. Please ensure your child comes prepared with weather-appropriate clothing (e.g. jumper, waterproof coat), a drink, sports kit, trainers and shin pads if playing football.

We are extremely proud of the wide range of extra-curricular opportunities we offer our pupils. Funds raised through club attendance are reinvested directly into our after-school provision, helping to provide equipment, cover travel costs, and support other essentials that enhance the quality of our clubs. Families eligible for Pupil Premium funding may access one free club place per term (subject to availability). To access this, please purchase your club place in the usual way and then contact the school office. A refund will be issued as soon as possible.
