## Year 4 Residential to Chester Trafford Hall 2024

Dear Parents/carers,

We are excited to share details of the new annual overnight residential for our Year 4 children, which has been arranged for **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024** at Chester Trafford Hall. **All four classes will attend the centre on this day and stay for one night** returning to school the next day in time for the end of school day.

The cost of this visit will be £105 for each child, this includes a 1-night stay, breakfast, lunch on both days, evening meal and a variety of activities themed around the adventure book series Alex Rider by Anthony Horowitz. Whilst on the trip, the children will transform into ground-breaking spies working effectively as a team to complete a range of challenges linked to the book. The activities the children complete may include orienteering, shelter building, fire lighting, code-breaking games, gadget design and archery. They will be able to experience the great outdoors whilst developing a love of reading.

To secure a place for your child, please complete the return slip below and send it back to school by **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024** and **pay a non-returnable deposit of £10.00**. This is non-negotiable and we cannot accept any slip after this date. By returning the slip and deposit, you are committing to accepting a place for your child and **making full payment by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024.** Payments can be made online via Parent Mail.

This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which is outside of school hours; therefore, school will require full payment for this trip. Please complete the return slip below and send it back to school if you wish your child to take part on this visit. Please remember that forms will not be taken after **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024**. This is without exception.

You will be invited into school on **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May** for a meeting where we will share further information and final details of the trip.
