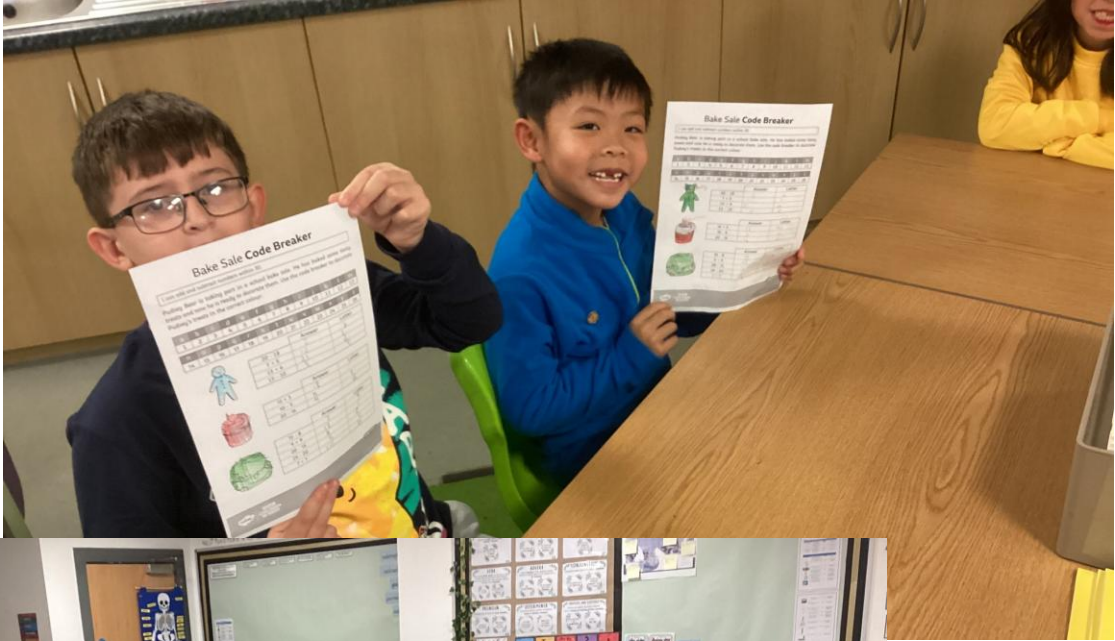
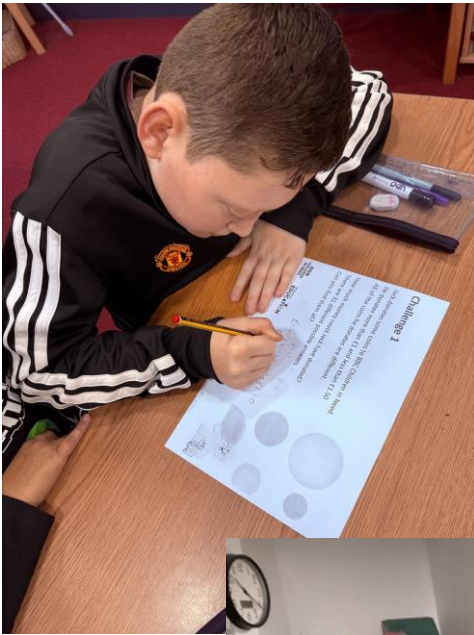

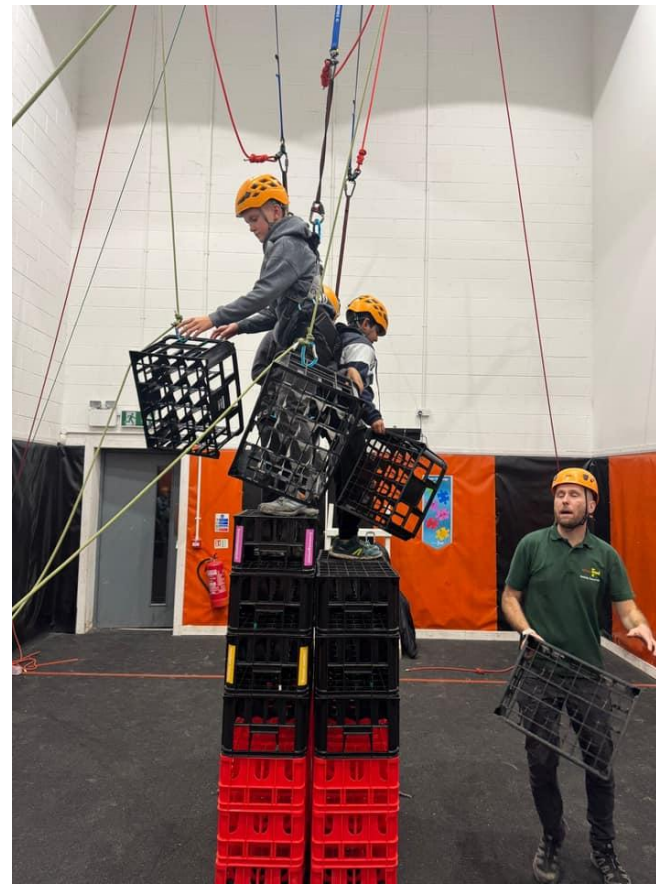


## Let's reflect on this half term...

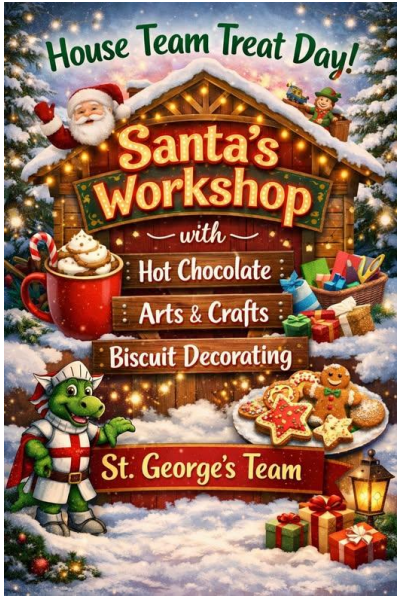




## We show Creativity
