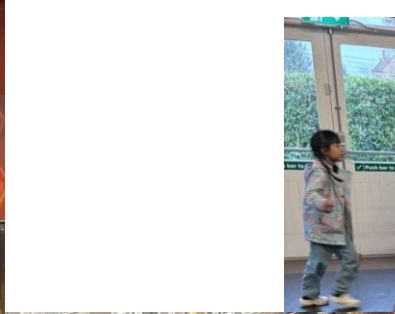

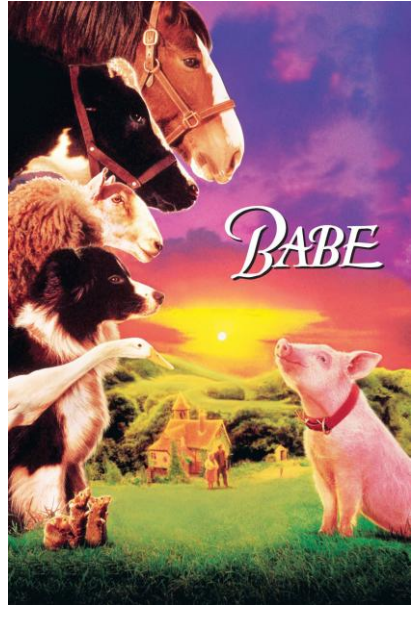

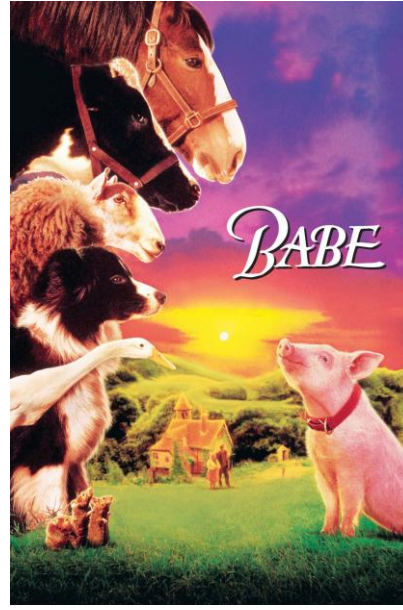
We celebrated our achievements with St Patrick's house winning the end of Spring term treat. KS1 children enjoyed a cosy cinema treat in the school hall.
