Dear Parent/carer,

As I am sure you will be aware, our year 6 children, as part of Enterprising week, have been learning about running a business. ChaPTA have invited Year 6 to take part in a Dragons' Den Entrepreneurial themed project and, as part of this process, Year 6 have worked in teams to create a business plan that will help them to raise money for the school community. This business plan has been presented to the Dragons who have approved them. These plans include selling raffle tickets, making braids, face paints, penalty shoot outs and much more. ChaPTA will be investing in their stalls and ideas to help buy the equipment and products they may need. The winning team, the team that makes the most profit minus the money they have borrowed to buy their equipment, will be entered in a draw to win a fantastic prize.

The children have been invited to run their stalls at the next ChaPTA event, the Treasure Hunt. The event starts at 3:30pm and ends at 6:00pm so the children would set their stalls up at the end of the day. Children may stay for some or all of the event. Permission to walk home can be granted in the same way as after school clubs until 4:15pm, however any time after this, they must be collected by an adult. As there will be a few children running each stall, they will be able to take a break during the time and visit the other stalls or take part in the Treasure Hunt alongside family if tickets have been purchased. Class teachers will help them to organise the logistics within their team so that they can continue selling their product and attend the Treasure Hunt.

As this event takes place after school, please complete the permission slip if your child is able to stay. They do not have to stay for the full duration and can be collected at a time that suits. We would appreciate if you could reply as soon as possible to allow the teams to organise their schedules. If forms could be returned no later than Wednesday 3rd July, that would be greatly appreciated.
