Dear Parent/carer,

As I am sure you will be aware, our year 6 children, as part of Enterprising week, have been learning about running a business. ChaPTA have invited Year 6 to take part in an Entrepreneurial themed project and, as part of this process, Year 6 have worked in teams to create a business plan that will help them to raise money for the school community. This business plan has been presented to the teachers who have approved them. These plans include penalty shoot outs, glitter tattoos, darts, carnival games and much more. ChaPTA will be investing in their stalls and ideas to help buy the equipment and products they may need. The winning team, the team that makes the most profit minus the money they have borrowed to buy their equipment, will be entered in a draw to win a fantastic prize.

The children have been invited to run their stalls at the next ChaPTA event on **Wednesday 18th June 2025**. The event **starts at 3:30pm and ends at 5:30pm** so the children would set their stalls up at the end of the school day. Children may stay for some or all of the event. Permission to walk home can be granted in the same way as after school clubs until 4:15pm, however any time after this, they must be collected by an adult. When a child is collected, they must inform a Year 6 teacher as a register will be taken. In order to make collection smoother we ask that parents only collect at designated times from the year 6 building; collections will be either 4:15pm and 5:30pm. This allows teachers to be more readily available to support the children with the stalls.

As there will be a few children running each stall, they will be able to take a break during the time and visit the other stalls. Please note that if purchasing food, the children will be responsible for any allergens as teachers will not be with the children directly at this time.

As this event takes place after school, please complete the electronic permission if your child is able to stay; please note that without permission, children will not be able to stay and support. We would appreciate if you could reply as soon as possible to allow the teams to organise their schedules. If forms could be returned **no later than Friday 13th June,** that would be greatly appreciated.
