Year 2 trip to Weaver Hall Museum, Northwich: Tuesday 31st March 2026.

We would like to invite your child on an exciting Year 2 trip to Weaver Hall Museum, Northwich. Weaver Hall Museum and Workhouse provides strong opportunities for pupils to engage with historical enquiry as part of their Great Fire of London topic in history and to have an immersive experience, meeting real characters from history through live interpretation that both informs and inspires them.

The children will be taking part in a special *Great Fire of London* workshop. During the session, the children will explore how the fire began, why it spread so quickly and how London was rebuilt afterwards. Through hands-on activities, storytelling and real historical artefacts, the workshop will bring their history learning to life and help them imagine what life was like in 1666. We're looking forward to a fun, engaging and memorable experience that will deepen their understanding of this important event.

Children will be required to be in school for the usual time of 8.50am. We will return to school in time for the end of the school day.

Any children not having a school pack lunch will need to provide their own in a disposable bag clearly marked with their name. Disposable drinks are also preferred in order to prevent children having to carry their water bottles all day.

Children will need to wear school uniform. With the changeable weather, please consider suitable footwear and send a coat as some of the activities will take place outside.

The cost of this trip is £20.00 per child, to cover the cost of the coach and must be paid before the date of the trip via Parentmail.
