## Gulliver's World Trip - Year 2

Dear Parents.

We are excited to share details of the annual overnight residential for our Year 2 children has been arranged from Thursday 3rd April. All three classes will attend the centre on this day and stay for one night.

The cost of this visit will be £92.00 for each child, this includes a 1-night stay, breakfast, lunch on both days, evening meal, activities led by Gulliver's World staff and entrance into the theme park for the children to enjoy some time on the rides with friends. The activities children will participate in are fun and engaging sessions which link closely to the Year 2 curriculum. This includes a plant and wildlife hunt around the park, a scooter safari, discovering what the site was like when it was RAF Burtonwood and many more interactive, team-building and problem-solving activities and a night-time disco. Please note that in order to keep the cost as low as possible, we ask that parents drop off and collect directly at Gulliver's World at 9:30am on the 3rd April and collect at 2:30pm on the 4th April which will hopefully support school drop off and collection for siblings.

To secure a place for your child, please complete the return slip below and send it back to school by Friday 4th October 2024 and pay a non-returnable deposit of £10.00. This is non-negotiable and we cannot accept any slip after this date. By returning the slip and deposit, you are committing to accepting a place for your child and making full payment by Friday 28th March 2025. Payments can be made online via Parent Mail.

This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which is outside of school hours therefore, school will require full payment for this trip. Please complete the return slip below and send it back to school if you wish your child to take part on this visit. Please remember that forms will not be taken after Friday 4th October 2024. This is without exception.

Parent consent for a visit must be received in school before the deadline for any educational visits and residentials. For the purposes of effective planning, any late submissions cannot be considered after the deadline stated.

If your child requires any medication whilst on the trip, please complete our 'Administered Medication Form' which is available from the school office and will need to be handed to the class teacher 14 days prior to the trip. You will be invited into school closer to the time for a meeting where we will share further information and final details of the trip. We will send a letter to communicate further details about this. We want as many of our children to attend the trip as possible as we know the lifetime memories these visits create for the children alongside the boost to confidence and independence. If your child has any questions or concerns about attending, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher directly so that we can support.
