## **EYFS Trip to Kenyon Hall Farm**

Dear parents and carers,

I am writing to you to share details about an upcoming trip that we have planned for the children in EYFS. We are excited to share that we have booked a visit to Kenyon Hall Farm, which will take place on **Friday 4th July 2025**.

This will be a full-day trip during school hours so children should be dropped off and collected from school as usual. Children are required to wear their school uniform and to bring a packed lunch. If you would like your child to have a packed lunch provided by school, please choose an option via the link provided. Alternatively, if you prefer to send a packed lunch from home, it must be in a named, throw-away bag. Please note, home-packed lunches should not contain sweets, fizzy drinks, anything containing nuts, or glass bottles.

This is a trip that we have been on before with previous year groups and it has always been very successful. It is an engaging, practical way to deliver and embed learning beyond the classroom. The trip will be linked to the children's Understanding the World learning, specifically as part of their *Growing* topic. The children will explore topics such as growing plants, the life cycles of seeds, and healthy eating. The day's activities will include:

- Fruit picking
- Tractor and trailer tour of the farm
- A lesson about food and farming

As this trip is an optional extra, the cost will be **£21.50 per child**, which includes transport. Permission forms and payments should be completed online via Parentmail by **Monday 9th June 2025**.

### **Important Information:**

- If your child has asthma or requires any medication, please ensure they bring their inhaler or medication with them on the day. Without this, they will not be able to attend. You can complete the 'Administered Medication Form' at the school office for any medicines your child may need.
- As the trip will involve a lot of outdoor activities, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. If it's sunny, please make sure they have a sunhat and suncream, and if it's rainy, please send them with a suitable raincoat.

We are looking forward to this wonderful learning experience for the children, and we appreciate your support in making this a successful trip. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact the school.
