




Year 1

and we wrote instructions for aliens visiting planet Earth!




We contributed to a whole school display.

We wrote down our strengths on a piece of paper and made them into a paperchain!






We talked about how we would feel if we didn't share our feelings!



We have weekly Commando Jo lessons where we talk about values such as respect, perseverance and always trying our best!




In Science we have been learning about the five senses and the human body!

We voted on whether we thought Jesus had been baptized.




Year 1 have been working very hard with their phonics since coming back to school!
