Year 6 London Residential visit 8th – 10th December 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are very excited to announce details of the Year 6 residential which will take place in December 2025 (the next academic year). We have made the decision to combine the usual two night residential with the London day trip to enable the children to be able to explore the capital city a little more and benefit from some of the wonderful learning opportunities. The trip will consist of a visit to the London science museum including a workshop, the Tower of London, the Tate gallery, St Paul's cathedral, a sightseeing cruise along the Thames, a West End show as well as all the usual sightseeing including seeing Buckingham Palace, Parliament and Downing Street. The guide price is £335 and is fully inclusive of two night's accommodation, meals (Frankie and Benny's and Pizza Hut for evening meals), drinks, snacks and all coach travel to, from and around London. A packed lunch will be required on the day they leave in a named disposable bag, and we ask that they contain no nuts, sweets, glass bottles or fizzy drinks. It is a jam- packed visit and to make the most of the time we will have an early departure time of 7:00am and late return of 7:00pm. The price may be adjusted depending on number of pupils sharing collective costs such as the coach travel but we are not anticipating it to increase more than £5 beyond the guide price.

I know that the children have only just had their year 5 residential visit and this may seem like a lot of advanced warning, however we need to confirm numbers to secure the booking and want to give as much notice as possible as we appreciate the significant cost involved. We believe that this offers a once in a lifetime opportunity and hope that as many children as possible are able to experience it.

The cost of the trip can be paid in instalments and must be paid online via Parentmail (We are a cashless school, however if you have any issues paying online, please contact the school office to discuss alternative arrangements). If you would like your child to attend, please complete the permission form and pay a non-refundable deposit of £10.00 by Monday 7th July 2025. Please note that both of these are required to secure a place. School cannot accept late permission form and payment of the deposit, you are committing to accepting a place for your child and making full payment. This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which is outside of school hours, therefore school will require full payment for this trip.

Payment schedule:

Monday 7th July: £10 deposit (committing to making full payment) Wednesday 1st October: £150 interim payment Monday 1st December: £175 final payment
