Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to provide you with further information about our upcoming residential trip to London next week, taking place from **Thursday 11th to Friday 12th December.**

I previously informed you that we would be travelling by train from Warrington Bank Quay to London Euston. Although the route remains the same, the departure time on Thursday 11th December has changed to ensure that we can be seated together on the same train and maintain the safety of all children. We therefore ask that your child is dropped off at the front entrance of Warrington Bank Quay station at 9:45am to be registered by staff and taken up to the platform, ready to depart at 10:24am. It is very important that your child arrives on time. If your child arrives after 10:15am, it will be the parent's responsibility to take them up to the platform.

Our journey home remains the same as previously communicated. We will be leaving London Euston on **Friday 12th December at 6:30pm** and will return to Warrington Bank Quay at **8:14pm**. Please ensure that your child is collected at **8:15pm**. As we will be arriving late in the evening, and to safeguard all children, it is essential that your child is collected by an adult and not a sibling.

As the day will involve plenty of sightseeing and walking, your child will be required to wear comfortable clothing, including a suitable waterproof coat and comfortable footwear. It is essential that your child packs their belongings in a suitably sized rucksack, as we cannot accommodate larger bags on the train.

Your child will also need a **disposable packed lunch** for the first day of the trip. As they will be responsible for carrying it, please ensure the lunch is a suitable weight and size and that they do not pack too much. We are a nut-free school, so no nuts are permitted on this trip. Disposable drinks are preferred so children do not need to carry their water bottles all day, but please ensure there are no fizzy drinks or glass bottles. All other meals will be provided and are included in the cost of the trip.

Children may bring a small activity for the train journey, such as a card game or a small travel game. However, we kindly ask that **no electronic devices** are brought on the trip. Digital cameras are permitted if your child wishes to take photographs, although staff will also be taking plenty of pictures throughout the day to share with parents on our school Facebook page.

Much of this information was shared during our Parent Information Evening in November. A copy of the details from that evening can be found on the Year 6 page of our school website for your reference.
