In EYFS, the week commencing 5th February we will be celebrating and learning lots of new facts about Lunar New Year. Over the week the children will learn all about the Chinese culture, how they celebrate their new year and all about the story of the Chinese Zodiac. On **Friday 9th February** the children will be taking part in special Chinese Dragon Dance Workshop. The professional dancers bring a traditional Chinese dragon, parasols and fans for each class to create an exciting dance performance.

On **Friday 9th February** we will be having a special celebration day to celebrate all the learning we have done over the week. To get into the spirit of Lunar New Year the children can come to school wearing their own clothes, preferably wearing something red or gold for the celebration. We will also be making some Lunar New Year fruit kebabs to eat in class. Any allergies that your child may have will be catered for, however please let your child's class teacher know if you don't want your child to participate in the food tasting.
