### **Year 1 Neil Armstrong Workshop**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very excited to offer our Year 1 children the opportunity to take part in an engaging workshop titled "Neil Armstrong: From Childhood Dreams to Walking on the Moon." This workshop will bring our learning about space to life through storytelling, role-play and hands-on activities.

The workshop will take place during the school day on **Friday 6th February for Class 5 and Friday 13th February for Class 4 and 6**. The workshop will last approximately two hours and will take place within the Year 1 classrooms.

During the session, children will learn about Neil Armstrong's life, what inspired him to become an astronaut and the training needed for the moon landing. They will take part in role-play, movement and artefact handling to support their understanding.

As you may remember, during the autumn term we asked for a voluntary contribution of £7.50 from all parents to help support the cost of workshops and visits in school. The cost of this workshop is covered by those contributions.
