We are very excited to offer our Year 1 children the opportunity to experience a Neil Armstrong workshop this half term on **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February for classes 4 and 5** and on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February for class 6** to help bring the history curriculum alive.
