Dear Parents and Carers,

Earlier this year, I wrote to you regarding the supervision of the playground equipment before and after school. Unfortunately, we are still observing a significant number of pupils using the equipment during these unsupervised times, which poses a health and safety risk. Risk assessments have been carried out on all equipment with appropriate levels of supervision advised which can not be adhered to before and after school.

Teachers have spoken with their classes this week to reinforce this message, and we kindly ask that you share the same reminder at home. We know how fortunate our children are with the amazing selection of outdoor activities and we do understand the temptation to have an extra little play, but would really appreciate your support in this manner.

We will now be monitoring this more closely. Any pupils found using the playground equipment, including the sandpit, before or after school will be required to miss some break time as a consequence as it is essential that children understand the importance of the message.
