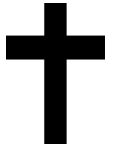

# Sikhism Year 3

I go to a **Gurdwara** to worship and pray.

My religious book is the **Guru Granth Sahib** - the sacred scripture of Sikhism.

I worship **God** and **only God**. I worship God in his true abstract form.

We really like to chant. During worship, we always include prayers that are sung or chanted. The chanting, known as **kirtan**, is a form of call-and-response, which means everyone can participate.

# Sikh Dharma Year 4

If I follow **Sikhism** I am a **Sikh**.

I go to a **Gurdwara** to worship and pray. Although, I can pray at any time and any place.

My religious book is the **Guru Granth Sahib** - the sacred scripture of Sikhism, a religion of India.

I worship **God** and **only God**. I worship God in his true abstract form. I can start the day by meditating to God.

We really like to chant. During worship, we always include prayers that are sung or chanted. The chanting, known as **kirtan**, is a form of call-and-response, which means everyone can participate.



# Judaism Year 5



Where can we find guidance about how to live our lives?

Why is it sometimes difficult to do the right thing?



If I follow Judaism I am **Jewish**.

I go to a **Synagogue** to worship and pray. If I am a boy, I may have a **bar mitzvah** or if I am a girl, I may have a **bat mitzvah** here.

My religious book is the **Torah**. It is sacred, so anybody who uses it must use a pointing tool called a **yad** rather than touching it.

I believe **God** created the world and Israel is known as the Holy Land to Jewish people. When I pray, I cover my head with a **kippah** as a sign of respect to God. I pray three times a day - in the morning, afternoon and evening.

A symbol of mine is a six-pointed star called **Star of David**. It is to grant protection of David, who was an important Jewish King.

We celebrate **Shabbat** to represent a day of rest. It begins on a Friday evening and ends on Saturday evening.



# Buddhism Year 6

Is lifelike a journey?

What do we mean by a 'good' life?



If I follow Buddhism, I am a **Buddhist**.

I go to a **temple or monastery** to worship and pray. I may meditate or pray there. I also have a home shrine to worship privately surrounded by fresh flowers, lights and lamps, incense and images of Buddha.

My religious book is the **Tipitaka**. It is written in an ancient Indian language called **Pali** which is close to the language Buddha himself spoke. I have one spiritual leader called '**the Buddha**' or '**the Awakened One**'.

When I pray, I devote my time to **Buddha and to Bodhisattvas**. I sit on the floor barefoot facing an image of Buddha and chanting.

I try to behave well through life by believing in **Karma**. I believe that bad behaviour in the present creates more suffering in the future.
