Relationships and Sex Education Policy Consultation

Dear Parent/Carer

The Department for Education has introduced new relationships and sex education (RSE) and health education guidance, that we're required to follow from **1st September 2026**.

Consequently, we are consulting on our Relationships and Sex Education Policy, with the **consultation opening on 8th June and closing on 29th June 2026**. Our schools have worked hard to make sure their curriculum meets the DfE's new requirements, as well as the needs of all pupils and takes account of;

- Pupils' ages and developmental stages, as well as their physical and emotional maturity and cultural and religious backgrounds
- Every pupil's learning needs, including the needs of any pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND)
- The vision and values of our schools
- What pupils need to know to be healthy and safe in school, in their personal relationships and in the wider world

We have updated our Relationship and Sex Education Policy to reflect the new guidance.

Our aims for this consultation are to:

- Explain the changes to our RSE Policy for September 2026
- Explain how we currently teach RSE, and get your views on how well this curriculum works
- Get your views on what else you think our RSE curriculum should cover
- Explain how we'll develop our updated curriculum and offer support to you to discuss some key topics at home with your child.

You will find a link to our **RSE Consultation via our school website from Monday 8th June**. Please do take the time to read the information and resources linked and provide us with your feedback. **The deadline for responding to the consultation is 29th June 2026**. The information and resources will be available for you to access across the remainder of this academic year and following the consultation, and once we've considered all of your comments, we'll feedback our findings and update our RSE policy, which will confirm our proposed curriculum and be ratified by Trustees.
