Dear Parents and Carers.

We would like to invite you to a SATs information session to be held at 5:30-6:00pm on **Wednesday 20th March.** The session will provide you with information and support for the SATs assessments which your child will be undertaking during May. Although the KS1 SATs are not a statutory assessment this year, as a school we have chosen to still deliver them to further inform our teacher judgements for the end of KS1. There will be an opportunity for us to explain the timetabling of the assessments and to show you some examples of past papers. There will also be the Year 2 staff on hand to answer any questions or to give advice on ways to support your child. Please come to the main school office where you will be directed to a Year 4 classroom.

The session will cover:

- 1. **Introduction to Assessments:** An overview of the assessment arrangements and expected standards for Year 2.
- 2. **The Assessment format:** Insight into the layout and questions within the Reading, Maths and Spelling papers.
- 3. **Home-School Partnership:** Tips and suggestions on how you can further support your child at home.
- 4. **Q&A Session**: An opportunity to ask any questions you may have about the assessments.

This presentation is a fantastic opportunity for you to gain a deeper understanding of the assessment process, layout and questioning, alongside some materials to take home to support your child's progress and the opportunity to explore SATs style materials first hand. We hope to see you at the meeting.
