### After Two Long Years - Sports Days 2022!

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to share with you the dates and plans for this year's sports day. This letter provides an outline of the event and what day your child's events will be held on.

**Years 5 and 6 Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July 9.30am – 11.30am**

**Years 1 and 2 Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July 1.15pm – 3.00pm**

**EYFS Sports Day Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 1.15pm - 3.00pm**

**Years 3 and 4 Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> July 9:30am – 11:30am**

#### The event will run as follows:

- ❖ Children will take part in individual traditional races in their year groups. The children will have had the opportunity to select their preferred race and will have practiced before the big day!
- ❖ On the day we ask that children are dressed in sports clothing (shorts, T shirt and trainers) in their house colours so that they are easily identifiable rather than their usual school uniform.
- ❖ If you need a reminder of your child's house, please contact the school office or ask your child's teacher.
- ❖ We kindly ask that parents come in through the school via the school field gate (at the back entrance of school). This will be open for spectators 15 MINUTES before the start time of Sports Day. All parents must enter via the entrance at the back of the school located within the community car park.
- ❖ There will be a designated area for spectators, and, for the safety of the children, it is important that **you remain on the spectator's side of the racetrack at all times**. There will be lots of staff around to speak to if you have any concerns or queries.
- ❖ As in previous years, children will continue to earn points for their house and will also receive recognition as individuals - having the chance to win gold, silver, or bronze positions in each of the traditional races.
- ❖ For all afternoon Sports days we will take children back into school at the end Sports Day to collect their belongings, so please collect your child from their classroom door at 3.15 as usual.
- ❖ We will have a limited number of chairs available to support some of our spectators. We kindly ask that you show respect and consideration for our spectators that require a chair as we will not have enough chairs for every spectator that attends. If you do use a chair, it would be a huge help and greatly appreciated if, once all the children (both Key Stage 1 and 2) have left the field, you could please take your



chair back to the chair stands, to support us clearing the school fields as quickly as possible at the end of the sessions.

### **PHOTOGRAPHS/VIDEOS**

We kindly and politely ask that you refrain from taking photographs or videos for the safety of all children in school and refrain from posting any information on social media. We will however be leaving this polite request at the discretion of our parents as our priority on the day is supervising the children and ensuring their safety and wellbeing.

Thank you, in advance, for your understanding and co-operation in this matter. We will update our school social media pages throughout the week of the Sports days in each year group.
