Summer Term After-School Clubs

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to share the exciting range of after-school clubs available for the Summer Term! At our school, after-school clubs are more than just activities; they are an opportunity for children to explore new interests, develop skills and spend time with friends in a fun and supportive environment.

Listening to pupil voice continues to be important to us and we always reflect carefully on the feedback children share about the clubs they would like to see. We are proud of the wide variety of clubs available and hope every child will find something that sparks their interest. There is a great mix of returning favourites and even some brand-new opportunities this term. Please see the overview of clubs available and for which year groups below. Please note that a separate letter regarding brass tuition will be sent at a later date.

What's new?

- Ukulele Club – led by Miss Davies, this club is a fantastic opportunity for absolutely anyone to learn a new musical skill, whether they are completely new to instruments or already enjoy music.
- Bat & Ball Club – led by Mr Capper, where children can enjoy a range of games including rounders, cricket and other fun team activities.

Signing up

- Sign-ups open on Monday 30th March at 5:00pm via ParentMail.
- Places are limited and are allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- If you have never used ParentMail to book a club place before, please contact the school office before this date so we can support you.

Club dates

Across the term, clubs will run for 9 weeks in total. Clubs will run from the week beginning Monday 20th April until week beginning Monday 6th July, except for Wednesday clubs. The final Wednesday club will be held on Wednesday 15th July. These breaks allow staff to support important whole-school events such as the OPAL Stay & Play session, the summer fair and Parents' Evening. Please see the schedule below for an overview of when clubs are running.

Collection and timings

A polite reminder that all clubs finish at 4:15pm. Please do not arrive early to collect your child while the club is still in session if it can be avoided. Early collection disrupts club activity and places unnecessary pressure on office staff. Please call ahead to inform us if you do require to pick your child up earlier than 4:15.

The collection points for each club are stated below in the club overview. Collection points are spread across school to ease congestion and reduce parents waiting for their children beyond 4:15pm. To support staff finishing prompt and to avoid any confusion for children, please ensure you collect from the correct place. If you require support collecting children from multiple clubs at the same time, please contact the school office in advance so we can help organise a smooth collection.

Walking home

Only children in Year 5 and Year 6 are permitted to walk home after clubs, and this must be supported by written parental permission. If this applies to your child, please ensure the school office has this information on file.

We are incredibly proud of the extracurricular opportunities we offer and the enthusiasm our pupils bring to them. Thank you for your continued support, and we look forward to seeing the children enjoy another fantastic term of clubs.
