and ticket stubs back to school by Wednesday 3rd June so that the draw can take place during the fair. If you are unable to support with selling them, we ask that you please simply return the tickets to school with your child so that they can be sold elsewhere. Should you be able to sell more than 5 tickets, please either pop into the office where they will have a supply or ask the class teacher.

The final event is a new addition and has been requested by pupils in school – the jam jar sale. If your child would like to take part, they simply have to repurpose a jar, decorate it and fill with something tasty or fun for others to enjoy. There will be a prize for each year group's most exciting jar and these will then be sold during the summer fair. Could jars please be in school no later than the morning of the 2nd June to allow the judges to choose the winners!

Lastly, and most importantly, please do come along and join in the fun on the day. As always, these events could not run without parental support and not only is it a lovely opportunity to come together as a school community, but all the children benefit through the money raised. Last year, we were blown away by both the generosity ahead of the fair and the support from families on the day.
