Dear Parent,

We have been advised that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the Year 2 year group. They attended school on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Your child has been confirmed as a close contact of the confirmed case.

**In line with national guidance you will need to keep your child at home from today and they must self-isolate until Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2020.** Please follow the guidance below: -

See information below from the national guidance:

- If you have been informed that your child is a close contact of a person who has had a positive test result for coronavirus (COVID-19), medical advice is clear: your child must immediately self-isolate at home for 14 days from the date of their last contact with them. There is no requirement for other members of your household to self-isolate unless anyone in your household starts to develop symptoms.
- **Your child must not go to school.** We are asking you to do this to reduce the further spread of Covid-19 to others in the community.

If you or your child begin to show the above symptoms you must follow the national guidance. For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness. However, if you develop symptoms you must self-isolate at home and arrange to have a test to see if you have COVID-19. Visit [NHS.UK](https://www.nhs.uk) to arrange or contact NHS 119 via telephone if you do not have internet access.

Please inform the school of any positive results.

We will continue to teach Year 2 pupils students remotely via Seesaw. The Year 2 teachers will be in contact with their class to explain how this will work.

Pupils will be welcomed back to school on **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2020** when their period of self-isolation is over.
