Dear Parent,

We have been advised that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the Year 2 year group. They attended school on Monday 9th November 2020. Your child has been confirmed as a close contact of the confirmed case.

In line with national guidance you will need to keep your child at home from today and they must self-isolate until Monday 23rd November 2020. Please follow the guidance below: -

COVID-19: Guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection.

See information below from the national guidance:

- If you have been informed that you child is a close contact of a person who has had a
 positive test result for coronavirus (COVID-19), medical advice is clear: your child
 must immediately self-isolate at home for 14 days from the date of their last contact
 with them. There is no requirement for other members of your household to selfisolate unless anyone in your household starts to develop symptoms.
- Your child must not go to school. We are asking you to do this to reduce the further spread of Covid-19 to others in the community.

If you or your child begin to show the above symptoms you must follow the national guidance. For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness. However, if you develop symptoms you must self-isolate at home and arrange to have a test to see if you have COVID-19. Visit NHS.UK to arrange or contact NHS 119 via telephone if you do not have internet access.

Please inform the school of any positive results.

We will continue to teach Year 2 pupils students remotely via Seesaw. The Year 2 teachers will be in contact with their class to explain how this will work.

Pupils will be welcomed back to school on Tuesday 24th November 2020 when their period of self-isolation is over.
