Year 3 Residential 2027: Tattenhall Activity Centre

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to confirm details of the Year 3 residential visit to the Tattenhall Activity Centre in Chester, which will take place in March next year.

The children will stay for one night, leaving school in the morning after registration and returning in time for the end of the school day the following day. **The total cost of the trip is £115**, which includes transport both ways, trip insurance, food, drinks, snacks and access to all the activities.

The itinerary is packed with exciting experiences, including on-site activities such as Jungle Camp, indoor art activities, team-building exercises and a campfire, as well as a visit to the Ice Cream Farm for a day of activities and, of course, ice cream! **Children will need to bring a packed lunch for the first day only.**

Residential dates are as follows:

- Class 10 – Departing 1st March and returning 2nd March
- Class 11 – Departing 2nd March and returning 3rd March
- Class 12 – Departing 3rd March and returning 4th March

The cost of the trip can be paid in instalments and must be paid online via ParentMail. As a cashless school, payments should be made electronically; however, if you experience any difficulties paying online, please contact the school office to discuss alternative arrangements.

If you would like your child to attend, please complete the permission form and pay a non-refundable deposit of £10 by Friday 17th July. Please note that both the completed permission form and deposit are required to secure a place. Unfortunately, the school cannot accept late forms or deposits after this date, and no exceptions can be made.

By submitting the permission form and deposit, you are confirming your child's place and committing to the following payment schedule:

- Non-refundable deposit: £10 by Friday 17th July
- Interim payment: £50 by Friday 28th November
- Final payment: Remaining balance by Friday 27th February 2026

This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which takes place outside school hours; therefore, full payment for the trip is required. Full Terms and Conditions regarding payment for educational visits can be found on the school website:
