Year 1 Pantomime Trip

Dear Parents,

We are very excited to announce a visit to the Brindley Theatre in Runcorn on **Wednesday 7th January 2026**, where the children in year 1 will be able to watch the traditional tale, Cinderella. This is a fabulous opportunity for your child to have the chance to experience a live performance with a professional cast of actors. All pupils in Key Stage 1 are taught to become very familiar with key stories, including folk and traditional tales. They learn to retell them and consider their characteristics. The National Curriculum states that children are taught to recognise and join in with predictable phrases of which a pantomime has in abundance! This trip enhances and supports their learning in an incredibly fun and enjoyable way. The children will be continuing their learning in the classroom where they will be given lots of opportunities to relive and share this experience.

Children will be leaving school at approximately 9.15 a.m. and will return to school at lunch time. We kindly ask that your child brings a suitable coat to wear on this trip. Due to the timing of their return, the children will have a packed lunch on arrival back in school. If you wish your child to have a free packed lunch provided by school, please choose an option via the link below for the sandwich filler; otherwise please select a home packed lunch. Home packed lunches need to come in with your child on the day but please note they must not contain sweets, fizzy drinks, anything that contains nuts or glass bottles.

The total price for this trip is £29.44 per child, including entrance fee, drinks, biscuits and the coach transport with fitted seat belts. **Please complete the electronic reply slip below if you wish your child to attend and complete by Thursday 4th December 2025.** Please note that this trip is classed as an optional extra therefore school will require full payment for this trip.

If your child suffers from Asthma, please make sure that they have their inhalers with them or any other medication they might be taking on the day or they will not be able to go on this visit. Our 'Administered Medication Form' is available from outside the office and will have to be filled in for any medicines being taken.
