## Year 4 Llandudno Residential visit May 2026

Dear Parent/carer,

We are excited to share details of the overnight residential to North Wales for our Year 4 children, which has been arranged to take place from 18<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> May 2026.

## All three classes will attend the trip on different days and each stay for one night.

- Class 14 will be visiting on Monday 18th May
- Class 15 will be visiting on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May
- Class 16 will be visiting on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May.

The full cost of this trip is £129 and is fully inclusive of accommodation at the Llandudno Hostel for Schools, a trip to the Welsh Mountain Zoo including an educational workshop on habitats and adaptations, a tram ride up the Great Orme, a visit to the Great Orme Mines, breakfast, lunch and an evening meal at the hostel, an evening meal at McDonalds on the day of return and lots of fun at the seaside!

Children will leave school after morning registration however a later evening return time of 7:00pm the next day ensures that children really get the most out of their time in Llandudno. A packed lunch will be required on the day they leave in a named disposable bag, and we ask that they contain no nuts, sweets, glass bottles or fizzy drinks. The cost of the trip can be paid in instalments and must be paid online via Parentmail (We are a cashless school, however if you have any issues paying online, please contact the school office to discuss alternative arrangements).

To secure a place for your child, please complete the return slip below and send it back to school by Wednesday 1st October and pay a non-returnable deposit of £10.00. Payments can be made online via Parent Mail. This deposit is non-negotiable, and we cannot accept any slip after this date. By returning the slip and deposit, you are committing to accepting a place for your child and making full payment by Friday 1st May 2026. An interim payment of £50 is required by Monday 2nd March 2026. This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which is outside of school hours, therefore school will require full payment for this trip. Please remember that forms will not be taken after **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March**. This is without exception.

## Payment schedule:

£10 deposit by 1st October 2025 £50 interim payment by 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026 £69 final payment by 1st May 2026
