### Year 5 Llandudno Residential Visit May 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are very excited to announce that once again year 5 children are invited to attend the Year 5 residential visit to North Wales staying at the Llandudno Hostel for Schools in Llandudno for one night. The trip will consist of a visit to the Welsh mountain zoo including a ranger-led talk about habitats, a tram ride up the Great Orme, a visit to the mines and lots of time to explore the seaside and play lots of team games. The guide price is £98 and is fully inclusive of accommodation, meals, drinks, snacks and includes all coach travel. A packed lunch will be required on the day they leave in a named disposable bag, and we ask that they contain no nuts, sweets, glass bottles or fizzy drinks. It is a jam-packed visit and to make the most of the time we have a later return time of 7:00pm and the children have McDonalds prior to departure from Llandudno. The price may be adjusted depending on number of pupils sharing collective costs such as the coach but we are not anticipating it to increase beyond the guide price.

I know that the children have only just had their year 4 residential visit and this may seem like a lot of advanced warning, however we need to ascertain numbers before we can determine in which way we organise the trip. We have traditionally had each class visiting for one night on their own however to support with the cost of the trip, we are looking to see whether it is possible to do two classes together.

The cost of the trip can be paid in instalments and must be paid online via Parentmail (We are a cashless school, however if you have any issues paying online, please contact the school office to discuss alternative arrangements). If you would like your child to attend, please complete the permission slip and pay a non-refundable deposit of £10.00 by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2024. **Please note both of these are required to secure a place. School cannot accept late slips or deposits after this date – sadly this is without exception. By returning the slip and deposit, you are committing to accepting a place for your child and making full payment by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2025. This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which is outside of school hours, therefore school will require full payment for this trip.**
