## Year 5 Llandudno Residential Visit June 2024

Dear Parent/carer,

We are excited to share details of the annual overnight residential to North Wales for our Year 5 children which has been arranged for week commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2024. All four classes will attend the trip on different days and each will stay for one night returning to school the next day in time for the end of the school day. Class 18 will be visiting on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June, Class 19 on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June, Class 20 on Wednesday 5th June and finally Class 21 on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June.

The **cost of this trip is £90** and is fully inclusive of accommodation at the Llandudno Hostel for Schools, a trip to the Welsh Mountain Zoo, including an educational workshop on habitats and adaptations, a tram ride up the Great Orme, a visit to the Great Orme Mines, breakfast, lunch and an evening meal at the hostel, an evening meal to McDonalds and lots of fun at the seaside! A packed lunch will be required on the day they leave in a named disposable bag, and we ask that they contain no nuts, sweets, glass bottles or fizzy drinks. The cost of the trip can be paid in instalments and must be paid online via Parentmail (We are a cashless school, however if you have any issues paying online, please contact the school office to discuss alternative arrangements).

To secure a place for your child, please complete the return slip below and send it back to school by Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March and pay a non-returnable deposit of £10.00. This is non-negotiable and we cannot accept any slip after this date. By returning the slip and deposit, you are committing to accepting a place for your child and making full payment by Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024. Payments can be made online via Parent Mail. This residential is classed as an optional extra, part of which is outside of school hours, therefore school will require full payment for this trip. Please remember that forms will not be taken after Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March. This is without exception.

Parent consent for a visit must be received in school before the deadline for any educational visits and residentials. *For the purposes of effective planning, any late submissions cannot be considered after the deadline stated.*
