Year 6 Transition Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that this letter finds you and your families well at this time. We wanted to send an update for key events for year 6 at this particularly busy time of year.

The year 6 team have been busy sharing information with all of the secondary schools in order to make the transition as smooth and supportive as possible in September. As part of this process, we are asked to provide, positive- working groups. We will be asking the children for 3 nominated friends and as a school we will ensure they get at least one of these choices in their groups. As you can imagine, this is a complex process for the secondary schools and whilst they endeavour to support their choices, this is not guaranteed. We understand that it can be an anxious time for some so please do contact your child's class teacher in the first instance if you have any concerns or questions.

Warrington schools have agreed on the same transition dates which proved to be a really successful model last year. Individual secondary schools will write to parents directly, however please note that the dates are the 3rd and 4th July.

Year 6 Leavers Assembly

We have been fortunate in securing the theatre at Great Sankey High School for the Year 6 leavers' assembly this year. This will enable a better view for parents and a designated space for the children on the stage as well as high quality sound and lighting. We hope that this will make it a more enjoyable experience for all.

In order for children to be in school on their last day, we have scheduled this for Tuesday 16th July at 2:00pm. We anticipate the assembly will last approximately 45 minutes which will allow time for parents to collect younger children from school if required. Further information and tickets to follow.

On the last day, 19th July, there will be celebrations in school with the year 6 children and staff including the traditional final countdown. Parents are welcome to join us at 2:30pm where refreshments will be served and there will be an opportunity to take photos and say goodbyes.
