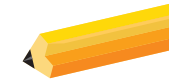

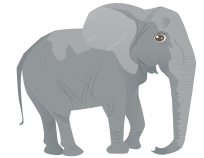

Use magazines or newspaper to cut out the letters you need to spell your spelling words. Stick them into your book.

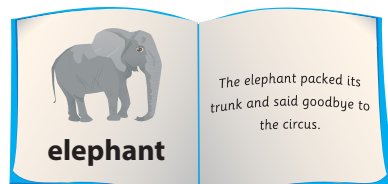

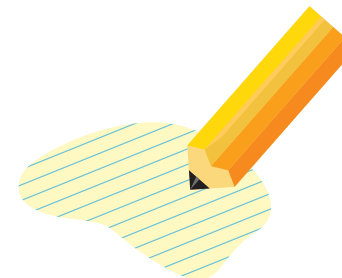

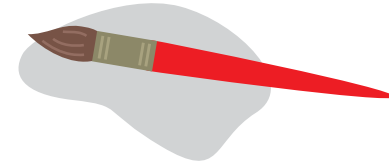

Carefully search the gardens to find sticks, leaves, twigs etc to make the letters of your spelling words.

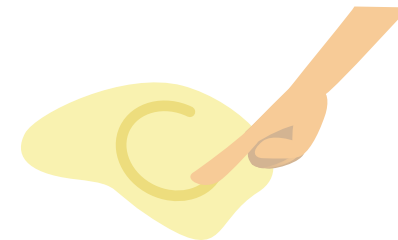


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# Sand Spelling

Carefully spread some sand out on your page. Spell each of your spelling words one at a time by tracing them in the sand.

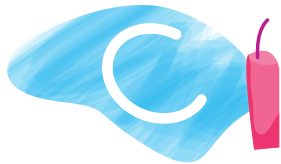


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# Invisible Words

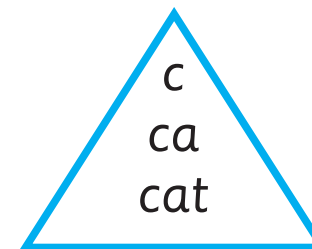

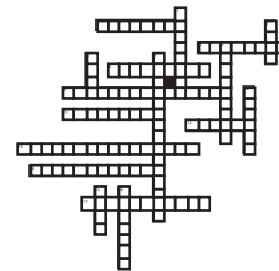

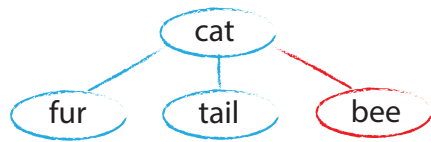


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# Odd One Out
