- **Travel Arrangements:** Timings for travelling to and from London by train and around the city by foot and tube, including guidance on what children should bring in their rucksacks.
- **Medical and Safety Information:** How we manage medicines, allergies, and any medical needs during the trip.

This meeting is a great opportunity to ask any questions you may have about the trip, the itinerary, or practical arrangements. We strongly encourage all parents and carers to attend so you have a full understanding of the residential and can feel confident your child will have a safe, enjoyable, and memorable experience.
