Primary Arts Network (PAN) Performance Opportunity

Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to offer some children across Years 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 the exciting opportunity to perform at this year's Primary Arts Network (PAN) event, within the local school community at the Parr Hall theatre. This is an exciting and valued opportunity and allows for the children to participate in a full performance of singing, dancing and instruments alongside other local schools and community members. The theme for this year's event is 'Once Spoken, Forever Echoed'. These children have been picked by class teachers for talents within performing arts as showcased in lessons in school and extra-curricular clubs such as choir or stage craft, so this offers a wonderful opportunity for the children to perform within the wider school community as a group. Some children will form the choir, some will be dancing and some playing musical instruments. All children will take part in a joint song which all schools will perform together.

On **Monday 23rd March** the children would be required to be dropped off at school as normal. The children will then be transported by local Warrington bus from school in time for a rehearsal at the Parr Hall at 2.30pm. Following rehearsal, there will be time for pupils to eat and have a break before the performance. There is no need to provide food as this will be done so by school, however if your child has any dietary requirements or food allergies, please can these be detailed on the electronic form. **The doors to the Parr Hall will be open from 5.30pm with the first performance at 6pm.**

The last performance of the evening is scheduled to finish at approximately 7:30pm however the time cannot be fully determined depending on how long each school's performance is. Please note that this is an estimated time and it could be before or after this time.

If you are unable to attend the evening, your child would need to be collected by an adult from inside the main entrance of the Parr Hall at around the time of 7.30pm. As I am sure you can appreciate when there are lots of children involved, this is a guide time only and we may need to ask you to be patient whilst we organise all children being collected safely.

As a school we are able to sell a maximum of 60 tickets, priced at **£5 per ticket**. These will be limited to **2 tickets per child** and **seats will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis**. The school has been given a designated area in which the tickets will be therefore all parents from Chapelford will be sat in one area. Your ticket, therefore, will not give you an allocated seat number; it will be first come first serve basis within our allocated seats. Upon purchase, these can be collected from the school front office.
